Salaries will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. All York University positions are subject to budgetary approval.

Adult Learning and Education

Applications are invited for an appointment in **Adult Learning and Education** at the rank of Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will contribute to the Bachelor of Arts in Educational Studies, the Master of Leadership and Community Engagement, other programs in the Faculty, and program development around education beyond the K-12 sector. The successful candidate will have an ongoing program of research and specialize in the theoretical and practical aspects of adult learning as it occurs in places such as community organizations, the health professions, industry, government, non-governmental and non-profit organizations, museums and galleries, adult education institutions, and other workplaces. A PhD by the start of the appointment in Education or a related field is required.

Aesthetics and Art Education

Applications are invited for an appointment in **Aesthetics and Art Education** at the rank of Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will contribute to the full range of programs in the Faculty, including the Bachelor of Education, and the Bachelor of Arts in Educational Studies. The successful candidate will have an ongoing program of research and specialize in educational engagements with art and culture, and the arts as a site of research, and teaching and learning, with a focus on aesthetic, arts-based and research-creation methodologies in educational research and pedagogy. A PhD by the start of the appointment in Education or a related field is required.

Mathematics Education

Applications are invited for an appointment in **Mathematics Education** at the rank of Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will contribute fully and broadly to mathematics education within the Faculty, including the Bachelor of Education and the Graduate Diploma in Mathematics Education. The successful candidate will have an ongoing program of research and specialize in areas such as: the teaching and learning of mathematics; mathematics in the elementary years; social justice and equity in mathematics; and mathematics teacher education. A PhD by the start of the appointment in Mathematics Education or a related field, and expertise in K-12 education and teacher education in the area of mathematics education, as well as knowledge of mathematics content and pedagogy as reflected in the Ontario curriculum are required.
